This millage will enable the school district to levy the statutory rate of 18 mills against non-homestead and non-qualified agricultural property required for the school district to receive its revenue per pupil foundation guarantee.

Shall the limitation on the amount of taxes which may be assessed against all property, exempting therefrom homestead and qualified agricultural property as defined by law, in Beaverton Rural Schools, Gladwin and Clare Counties, Michigan, be increased by 1 mill (\$1.00 on each \$1,000.00 of taxable valuation) for a period of 2 years, 2002 and 2003, to provide funds for operating purposes; the estimate of the revenue the school district will collect if the millage is approved and levied in 2002 is approximately \$96,351 (this millage will be levied only to the extent necessary to restore the "Headlee" reduction)?
