That the following Propositions or questions were passed or defeated as indicated below:

**TOBACCO TOWNSHIP
FIRE PROTECTION MILLAGE RENEWAL**

Shall the previously voted increase in the 15-mill tax limitation imposed under Article IX, Sec. 6 of the Michigan Constitution in Tobacco Township, Gladwin County, Michigan, of 1.5 mills (1.50 per \$1,000 of taxable value), which has been reduced by the required millage rollbacks, be renewed at 1.4794 mills (\$1.4794 per \$1,000 of taxable value) and levied for nine (9) additional years, 2011 through 2019 inclusive, for the purpose of contracting for fire protection services and for any other purpose authorized by law to provide fire protection services to the Township, raising an estimated \$154,948.21 in 2011?

**GLADWIN COMMUNITY SCHOOLS
OPERATING MILLAGE PROPOSAL**

This proposal will allow the school district to levy the statutory rate of 18 mills on all property, except principal residence and other property exempted by law, required for the school district to receive its revenue per pupil foundation allowance.

Shall the limitation on the amount of taxes which may be assessed against all property, except principal residence and other property exempted by law, in Gladwin Community Schools, Gladwin and Clare counties, Michigan, be increased by 0.8215 mill (\$0.8215 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) for a period of 2 years, 2012 and 2013 to provide funds for operating purposes; the estimate of the revenue the school district will collect if the millage is approved and levied in 2012 is approximately \$194,351 (this millage is to restore millage lost as a result of the reduction required by the Michigan Constitution of 1963)?
