The Board of Canvassers of the County of Gladwin having ascertained and canvassed the votes of said Regular Election, held on the 2th day of August, 2016.

DO HEREBY CERTIFY AND DETERMINE

That the following Propositions or questions were passed or defeated as indicated:

District Library General Fund Millage

Shall Gladwin County District Library be authorized to levy a tax annually upon the taxable value of all property subject to ad valorem taxation within the district of Gladwin County District Library in an amount not to exceed 0.4965 mills (just under 50 cents for each \$1,000 of taxable value) for a period of ten (10 years, 2016 through 2025, inclusive, to provide general funds for all district library purposes authorized by law?

This millage is a renewal of the previously authorized millage of ½ mill which expired following the 2015 levy. The rate requested for renewal is the current net rate after reductions applied pursuant to MCL 211.34d (Headlee) limitations, and is estimated to provide revenues of \$463,056 in the first year. To the extent required by law, a portion of the revenues from this millage collected on certain properties lying within established Downtown Development Districts will be captured by or disbursed to the Downtown Development Authorities of the Cities of Gladwin and Beaverton for authorized purposes. The amount of such capture is estimated to be approximately \$3,830 in the first year of the levy.

BILLINGS TOWNSHIP ROAD MILLAGE

Shall the Township of Billings place a new levy of 1.5 mills (1.5 mill is \$1.50 per \$1,000.00) of assessed taxable value as final equalized) for the purpose of providing road maintenance/improvement services exclusively for Billings Township. This millage will create matching to be used in conjunction with the current county road millage for Billings Township roads, for a four (4) year period 2016-2019 inclusive, commencing with the December 2016 tax billings. Said amount being in excess of the 15.6 mill limitation provided in Article IX Section 6 of the Michigan Constitution. This millage if approved is estimated to raise approximately \$140,000.00 the first year.






