Shall the limitation on the total amount of taxes which may be assessed each year against all property subject to taxation in Tobacco Township, Gladwin County, Michigan be increased by 1 mill (\$1.00 per \$1,000.00 of equalized taxable value) to provide mosquito abatement for a period of 5 years from 2018 through 2022 (this 1 mill increase will raise an estimated \$103,000.00 for the first year the millage is levied) as provided by Section 6, Article IX of the Constitution of the State of Michigan.
