The Gladwin County Board of Commissioners met in Special Session on Friday, March 16, 2018. The meeting was called to order at 10:30 a.m. by Chairman Walters. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Roll call found all Commissioners present.

Attorney Joshua Leadford from Masud Labor Law Firm introduced himself and provided the Board a packet that outlined the firm's background and qualifications for representation. Discussion.

Motion by Commissioner Hinman, supported by Commissioner Birgel, to return to regular session. Ayes carried, motion passed.


