The Board of Canvassers of the County of Gladwin having ascertained and canvassed the votes of said Regular Election, held on the 6th day of November, 2018

DO HEREBY CERTIFY AND DETERMINE

That the following Propositions or questions were passed or defeated as indicated:

Conservation District Proposal

Shall the tax limitation on general ad valorem taxes within the County of Gladwin imposed under Article IX, Sec. 6 of the Michigan Constitution be increased by 0.1500 mill (\$0.15 per \$1,000 of Taxable Value) on all real and personal property in Gladwin County for a period of five (5) years, beginning in 2019 through 2023, for the sole purpose of funding Gladwin Conservation District programs, including assist in the county gypsy moth and soil erosion programs, assisting landowners in the protection, enhancement, and restoration of natural resources; assist agricultural producers in the protection of soil and water implementation of best management practices on farmland; provide educational programs for county youth; continue water quality initiatives through the Cedar River Steering Committee and other such groups; provide annual tree sale programs; and provide invasive species evaluation and eradication efforts as time and money sees fit, within the boundaries of Gladwin County.

If approved and levied in full, this millage will raise an estimated \$140,000 for Gladwin Conservation District services in the first calendar year of the levy.

Beaverton City Road Improvement

Shall the City of Beaverton, Gladwin County levy a total of two mills (\$2.00 per \$1,000.00) on taxable value of property located in the City of Beaverton for twenty-five (2) years beginning with the 2019 tax year and running through 2043 tax levy year (inclusive), which will raise in the first year of such levy an estimated revenue of \$32.518.17 to be used for the purposes of road improvements initially to Glidden and Saginaw Streets as authorized by law. This levy would be collected on the summer tax bill of 2019, and collected on the winter tax bill thereafter. A portion of these revenues will be captured by the DDA and if approved, this would be a new authorized millage.

Shall the City of Beaverton, Gladwin County levy a total of two mills (\$2.00 per \$1,000.00) on taxable value of property located in the City of Beaverton for a period of five (5) years beginning with the 2019 tax year and running through 2023 tax levy year (inclusive), which will raise in the first year of such levy an estimated revenue of \$32,518.17 to be used for the purposes of providing public safety services as authorized by law. This levy would be collected on the winter tax bill of 2049, and collected on the winter tax bill of 2019, and collected on the winter tax bill thereafter. A portion of these revenues will be captured by the DDA and if approved, this would be a renewal of a previously authorized millage.

If approved and levied the estimated amount of revenue for the 2018 mosquito control would be approximately \$48,035.00.
