CERTIFICATE OF DETERMINATION

The Board of Canvassers of the County of Gladwin having ascertained and canvassed the votes of said Regular Election, held on the 8th day of November, 2016.

DO HEREBY CERTIFY AND DETERMINE

That the following Propositions or questions were passed or defeated as indicated:

Gladwin County Animal Shelter Proposal

Shall the tax limitation on General Ad Valorem Taxes within the County of Gladwin, imposed under Article IX section 6 of the Michigan Constitution, be increased by 0.20 mill (.20 per \$1,000.00 of taxable value) for 5 years, 2018-2022 inclusive, beginning with the December 2017 tax billing cycle, for the maintenance and operation of Gladwin County Animal Control, and shall the County be authorized to levy such increase in millage for said purpose, which will raise the first year an estimated \$188,070.96.

Note: If approved and levied, in accordance with State Law, a portion of the millage monies raised in their respective jurisdictions may be distributed to the Downtown Development Authorities of the cities of Beaverton and Gladwin.

Beaverton Township Road Improvement Millage

Shall the previously voted increase in the tax limitation imposed under Section 6, Article 9, of the Michigan Constitution, on general ad valorem taxes within the Township of Beaverton, State of Michigan, be renewed at 2 mills (\$2.00 per \$1,000 of taxable value) for a period of 5 years commencing on 2018 through 2022 inclusive for the purpose of constructing and improving

local roads; and shall the Township levy such renewal in millage for said purpose, thereby, raising in the first year an estimated \$93,942.00 commencing with the December, 2018 tax billing.

Bentley Township Fire Millage Proposal

Shall the Township of Bentley, Gladwin County, Michigan, be authorized to levy up to 1 mill (\$1.00 per \$1,000) on the taxable valuation of all properties, both real and personal, for the purpose of providing funds for, but not limited to, fire protection and the maintenance of a fire hall and vehicles. Said levy to be for a period of 1 year only beginning in Winter 2017, both inclusive, commencing with December 2017 Tax billing. Said levy will generate an estimated \$20,277.00 in the first year of collection.

Billings Township Road Millage

Shall the Township of Billings Place a new levy of 1.5 mills (1.5 mill is \$1.50 per \$1000.00) of assessed taxable value as final equalized) for the purpose of providing road maintenance/improvement services exclusively for Billings Township. This millage will create matching funds to be used in conjunction with the current county road millage for Billings Township roads, for a four (4) year period 2017-2020 inclusive, commencing with the December 2017 tax billing. Said amount being in excess of the 15.6 mill limitation provided in Article IX Section 6 of the Michigan Constitution. This millage if approved is estimated to raise approximately \$14,0000 the first year.

This millage proposal would allow Secord Township to renew it's previously authorized levy of one and one quarter (1.25) mil on taxable property in the Township of Secord, County of Gladwin for the purpose of the department operations and equipping funding. The present authorized levy expires 12/17. Shall the Township of Secord, Gladwin County, Michigan renew the existing millage of one and one quarter (1.25) mil in the limitation on the total amount of ad valorem taxes which may be imposed for all purposed upon real and personal property in the Township, as provided in Article 9, Section 4 of the Michigan Constitution of 1943, as amended, for a period of 6 years (2018 through 2024) inclusive, which levy would provide an estimated revenue to the Township for the Fire Dept. of \$115,646.00 in it's first calendar year if approved and levied for the purpose of providing for fire operations and equipment funding?

Shall the 15 mil tax limitation on general Ad Valorem taxes within Secord Township, Gladwin County, MI, be increased by up to 0.45 mil (\$0.45 per \$1000.00 of taxable value) on taxable value of real and personal property for a period of 2 years, 2018-2019 inclusive, and said millage be used exclusively for marine patrol safety? If approved and levied, the estimated amount of revenue for the 2018 marine patrol would be approximately \$41,632.00.

Secord Township Road Millage Renewal

This millage proposal would allow Secord Township to renew it's previously authorized millage and levy up to two and one quarter (2.25) mil on taxable property in the Township of Secord, County of Gladwin for the purpose of the construction and maintenance of roads and public rights of way in the Township. The present authorized levy expires in 12/17. Revenue from this millage will be disbursed to the Gladwin County Road Commission, which shall perform the construction and maintenance. Shall the Township of Secord, Gladwin County Michigan renew the existing millage of up to two and one quarter (2.25) mil in the limitation on the total amount of general ad valorem taxes which may be imposed for all purposed upon real and personal property in the Township, as provided in Article 9, Section 4 of the Michigan Constitution of 1943, as amended, for a period of 6 years (2018 through 2024) inclusive, which levy would provide an estimated revenue to the Township for road construction and maintenance of \$208,162.00 in its first year if approved and levied in full in roads and public right of ways within the Township?

If approved and levied, the estimated amount of revenue for the 2018 mosquito control would be approximately \$41,632.00
