PRESS RELEASE

FERC, Spicer Engineering, the operation employees of Boyce Hydro and the Emergency Manager Director of Gladwin County have issued an order to have the following bodies of water lowered effective May 21, 2020 beginning at 8:00 a.m.

Secord Lake, Smallwood Lake and the Tittabawassee River

This is being done to ensure the safety of our residents and to allow for the proper inspection of dams owned by Boyce Hydro.

Residents are URGED to remove all watercraft within three (3) days to guarantee proper storage of boats prior to the lake levels falling. At this time, there is not a determined date in which the water levels can be restored to seasonal levels, due to the possible need for repairs after the inspections are complete.

The County has also compiled a list of roads that are currently closed. This list will change daily. Please check your route before leaving your home to ensure you will be passing through safe roadways during your travels.

Please do not call 911 emergency services to inquire about road closures.
