#2 Flood Debris Pickup/Removal

- All items are to be placed curbside in front of your residence or business.
- You MUST SEPARATE any items that contain refrigerant from all other materials.
- Mark ALL furniture and appliances with a large “RED X” or the word “FLOOD” before setting out to your curbside. This will warn residents of potentially harmful materials and that they should not attempt to re-use in their home or sell.
- Photos and video must be taken of all debris set out for removal by the waste care provider.

2-1-1 continues to handle all other services in response to the flood. Services include: Property Damage Claims, Food and Supplies, Financial Donations and Donations of Household Supplies and Goods.
