

**CANVASS OF VOTES CAST AT THE
SPECIAL ELECTION HELD ON**

Tuesday, May 4, 2021, in Beaverton School, Gladwin and Clare Counties, Michigan (the "District"), and canvassed by the Board of County Canvassers of Gladwin County, Michigan.

STATEMENT OF VOTES

The statements of votes polled in the three (3) voting precincts of the District, at the Special Election held on Tuesday, May 4, 2021, and filed with the County Clerk, and this Board, having duly examined and considered the statements, do hereby show the whole number of votes given for and against the proposition reading as follows:

BONDING PROPOSAL

Shall Beaverton Schools, Gladwin and Clare Counties, Michigan, borrow the sum of not to exceed Twelve Million Dollars (\$12,000,000) and issue its general obligation unlimited tax bonds therefor, in one or more series, for the purpose of:

remodeling, including security improvements to, furnishing and refurbishing, and equipping and re-equipping school buildings; acquiring and installing instructional technology and instructional technology equipment for school buildings; and developing and improving playgrounds, athletic fields and facilities, parking areas and sites?

The following is for informational purposes only:

The estimated millage that will be levied for the proposed bonds in 2021, under current law, is 1.55 mills (\$1.55 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation). The maximum number of years the bonds of any series may be outstanding, exclusive of any refunding, is twenty (20) years. The estimated simple average annual millage anticipated to be required to retire this bond debt is 2.34 mills (\$2.34 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation).

The school district does not expect to borrow from the State to pay debt service on the bonds. The total amount of qualified bonds currently outstanding is \$3,905,000. The total amount of qualified loans currently outstanding is \$0. The estimated computed millage rate may change based on changes in certain circumstances.

(Pursuant to State law, expenditure of bond proceeds must be audited and the proceeds cannot be used for repair or maintenance costs, teacher, administrator or employee salaries, or other operating expenses.)
