1. General Report

Gladwin County Planning Commission Presentation to County Commissioners October 12, 2010

The Gladwin County Planning Commission has determined the need for an amendment to the Gladwin County Zoning Ordinance. The required Public Hearing was held at the October 6, 2021, Planning Commission meeting. Required notices were published in the newspaper as mandated by state statutes. No letters of notification were required. The Planning Commission is recommending to the County Commissioners that changes be made to the ordinance as listed on the attachments, to be effective November 1, 2021.

Summary of Change to the ordinance

The text amendment will <u>amend Chapter 3</u>, <u>Section 3.2 of the Code of the County</u>. By doing this, it adds an Overlay District created in this Section to the B-2 District located within the Township of Hay as set forth in the Township of Hay Recreational Marihuana Facilities Ordinance effective June 18, 2021.

Also, within the Township of Beaverton to Parcels 010-025-303-001-01 and 010-010-100-001-02 only, both located within the Township of Beaverton as set forth in the Township of Beaverton Commercial Marihuana Facilities Ordinance.

Summary of Comments at Public Hearing, October 6, 2010

Assistant Zoning Administrator Kim Donn presented the proposed text amendment to the Planning Commission and read it aloud for the benefit of the audience. Motion was supported and carried by vote.

Good morning Mark!

Rhonda Reppert has historically managed the County Law Library, which counties are required to maintain, and which is funded in part by the County and in part by revenue generated from certain traffic offenses. The statute that directs money from ticket revenue to the law libraries has been relatively static over the years, while the cost of books/internet searching for legal access to the public has gone up. As such, according to Rhonda, we have regularly asked the Commissioners for funding out of the General Fund at the end of the year to cover the costs the library couldn't bear on its own. As of right now it appears that the Law Library will require \$2,600.00 to pay for the required books and software between now and the end of the year.

Is it possible that we could make that adjustment/request for adjustment soon, either by Administrative decision or at the next Board meeting? As I understand it, the fund (269-000-971.000) is depleted at present and there are bills due by the end of the month.

I'm happy to provide any further context as necessary.

Upgrades to Audiovisual systems in the court room will allow the Courts to conduct business, including jury trials, safely while enforcing social distancing, which is not altogether feasible at this juncture with current equipment.

Project Description:

The 55th Circuit Court and 80th District Court are currently unable to conduct all manner of hearings necessary to dispense justice for the people of Gladwin County because the audiovisual systems for the courtrooms are outdated, and in some cases, are no longer functioning. This was not a substantial issue pre-COVID, but with the requirement to socially distance, and a strong request from the Michigan Supreme Court to conduct hearings remotely, parties, jurors, and the judge all are further apart, and some parties are relying exclusively upon videoconferencing tools. Investing in new microphones, speakers, and court recording equipment will not only allow the courts to operate the way they are required to to protect the public from COVID-19, they will be necessary investments into the future where the courts will rely more on technology and videoconferencing specifically.

Project Outcomes:

This project will modernize the court's capacity to conduct hearings remotely, while also allowing in-person hearings to be better managed. Jurors, parties, and members of the public, will be able to better hear and communicate with the court, which is essential for just outcomes.

Required County Resources:

There should be little or no County Resources required if the funds for this project are approved. These are infrastructure investments that will pay dividends immediately upon completion, and should last for several years to come without further funding necessary. Any ongoing costs will be minimal for licensing of recording software which is already paid for out of the court's budgets will continue to be.

Project Justification:

It is a necessary means of continued operations of the courts in response to the COVID-19 pandemic, and allows for the residents of Gladwin County to take part in all manner of judicial proceedings they would have prior to COVID. It also saves money for hardware and software that would likely have had to be replaced using County funds if not for this opportunity and its direct relationship to responding to COVID-19.

Project ROI:

Saves County resources from future necessary investments.

Implications:

Every resident of Gladwin County is served by the justice system, and nearly every person steps foot in a courtroom at some point in their life. In order to protect public safety and preserve the rights of all residents a functioning and open court is an absolute necessity. Hearings must be properly recorded in order to preserve rights if appeals are necessary, and being able to hear testimony and see evidence is the only way to determine the facts of a case.

Risk Assessment:

Continued neglect of audiovisual systems in the courts will make fewer and fewer proceedings possible, delaying justice and preventing parties from necessary compensation and the public from safe and swift justice.

Project Strengths:

This is a simple project with well-defined costs and a reasonable timeline that will allow the courts to operate at full efficiency without ongoing costs.

Project Weaknesses:

There are really no defined weaknesses to this project. It is a necessity, it is a relatively simple investment, and it will make a profound. The only weakness is that this project hasn't already started, as some court proceedings are being delayed for lack of audiovisual resources.

As the majority of the year, there has not been a Chief Deputy appointed in the Clerk's Office, line item 101-215-704 has approximately \$27,000 in unused funds for the year. I am requesting a transfer of funds from that line item to cover the cost of county expenses not accounted for in the 2021 budget, and a purchase request for a county projector. Expenses include:

- 1) The November 2021 Election, current cost to the county is just over \$14,000 plus election day wages.
- 2) The ID Card / Badge printer used to print ID Cards for the entire county needs repair / replacement. The current equipment gets stuck during the printing process and leaves a streak in the badges. The current printer was purchased in 2017, with a useful life expectancy of 4-6 years. The current machine is not a high-volume printer and has exceeded the number of prints anticipated for that machine. Below are pricing options for consideration:

Fargo ID Badge Card Printer

Repair Cost \$650 Replacement Cost \$1,500 Upgrade Cost \$1,875.96 (less discounts)
Useful Life: Unknown Useful Life: 7 yrs.

- 3) Death Record Book, used to record deaths in Gladwin County. These books are typically purchased once every 10 to 12 years, and the last one, purchased in 2008, is full. The cost of this book is \$711.88.
- 4) County Projector Purchase to be used by all departments as needed and stored and maintained by the County Administrators office. The county currently has no way of projecting for trainings, presentations, jury trials, or Zoom. The current use of the television is antiquated and has limited audio / visual capabilities. A projector would cost between \$500-\$700.

I am requesting a line-item adjustment to the Clerk's Office budget in the amount of -\$23,012 from the County Clerks Chief Deputy Wages 101-215-704 as follows:

\$15,000 to 101-191-727 Election Supplies and Printing

\$ 5,000 to 101-191-706 Election Wages

\$ 2,300 to 101-215-933 Equipment & Maintenance, or as recommended by the Data Committee.




