The Gladwin County Board of Commissioners met for a special Board Meeting, on June 28, 2022. The meeting was called to order at 11:07 a.m. by Chairperson Karen Moore. The Pledge of Allegiance was said, R. Grove is excused, all other Commissioners were present.

Approval of Agenda

New Business

1. Discussion on the funding of ARPA Projects

Commissioner Moore shared some information from Commissioner R. Grove regarding ARPA funding, and his thoughts on conversation at the last meeting.

A summary of how the board reached the current list and values was given.

Conversation was had on the values given to various projects, and possibly adjusting those values. It was noted that ARPA funds are being held in reserve for future projects or additional requests on these projects if needed.

The two Chamber projects in combination, will be increased by \$5,000, to at total \$100,000.

The Sports Complex will be increased by \$10,000, to a total of \$50,000.

The Probate & Family Court Van will be increased by \$5,000, to a total of \$25,000.

Discussion was had on reserve funds, and other obligations of the county.

Further conversation on how to announce the projects that would be receiving funds, and how the intergovernmental agreements would be worded to say "up to" a dollar value and "for" the specific purpose of the project.


Additional conversation was had on the "Parking Lot Projects". An additional meeting will be scheduled for further discussion.
