
New Business

Jail Issues


Sheriff Shea shared a brief building history at the jail, and the status of plumbing in several cells in need of repair. It was noted that the route of the plumbing is currently running under the generator. Undersheriff Hartwell, Jail Administrator McGourty, and Maintenance Supervisor Ghent shared additional information. Conversation was had on the roof top heat exchange unit, inmate population, and the timing of repairs, as well as the ability to outsource inmate population, and the need for floor repairs.

Motion by Commissioner Taylor to allow the Jail to move forward with Plumbing repairs at \$40,000, Rooftop Unit at \$14,000 and \$30,000 for Inmate Outsourcing. A total of \$84,000 to be paid from ARPA funds. Seconded by Commissioner R. Grove. All in favor, motion carried.

A motion was made by Commissioner R. Grove to adjourn, seconded by Commissioner Szuch. Special Joint Meeting adjourned at 9:02 a.m.
