

COUNTY CANVASS MINUTES OF AUGUST 6, 2008

The Gladwin County Board of Canvassers met at 1 p.m. on Wednesday, August 6, 2008.

Present were canvassers Mary Offenbecker, Judy Ford, Harold Cripe, Lou Kalinowski and Clerk Laura Flach.

As Mr. Kalinowski was a new appointee replacing Mr. Schafer, the Clerk administered the Oath of Office.

Clerk Laura Flach noted an apparent "tie" in the Buckeye Twp. Dem. Constable position, as well as giving notice to the board that a Petition for Recount had already been filed regarding the Billings Twp. Treasurer Democratic nomination.

The canvass then began.

After review of all the poll books and documents – nothing was found to be out of order.

The board authorized Clerk Laura Flach to schedule the "drawing" for the Buckeye Dem. Constable position and record the result with the Canvass minutes.

Election results were then certified, and all necessary documents signed.

The Clerk will schedule the (Billings) recount and notify canvass members, once the ballots have been released by the State of Michigan.

The meeting was adjourned at 3:45 P.M.
