The Gladwin County Board of Canvassers met at 9 a.m. on 8/27/04 to perform Recount for Billings Township Supervisor, Treasurer, Clerk, Trustee and Constable positions.

Present were members Offenbecker, Crandall and Gavin. They were assisted by Laura Flach, County Clerk in the absence of member McGillis.

The ballots were counted to determine that their number was the same as voters recorded in the poll book.

Secrecy envelopes were viewed to ascertain that there were no write-in votes which could lead to a cross-party vote. (No write-ins were found)

Ballot cards were then checked for cross-party votes by using the templates provided precincts from Miller Elections. Ballots found to have cross-party votes were then set aside - leaving ballots to be recounted.

Recounting then proceeded for the Supervisor position, with results as follows:

Recounting then proceeded for the Treasurer position, with results as follows:

Allen 248                      Wallace 179

Recount was then had for the Clerk position, with results as follows:

Aultman 233                      Stacy 217

Canvassers then recessed for lunch.

Meeting reconvened at 1 p.m. and recount continued.


