Minutes of November 7, 2001

The Gladwin County Board of Canvassers met at 1 p.m. on Wednesday, November 07, 2001 to canvass votes cast at the November 6, 2001 City Elections.

Present were members Mary Offenbecker and Bill Crandall with Clerk Laura Flach. Members Betty Gavin and Pat McGillis were unable to attend.

The records from the City of Gladwin - precincts 1 & 2, were reviewed first. All was found to be in order. The canvass documents were completed and signed.


Beaverton City precincts were then reviewed. It was found that precinct #2 recorded no votes for Charter Commission candidates whose names appeared on the ballot. However, sufficient votes were recorded from Precinct #1 & Precinct #3 to show those candidates with a clear margin of victory.

It was decided to certify the election using the totals received as the additional votes that may be obtained from precinct #2 would make no difference in the outcome. Write-in candidates-Bernice Wood, Jerry Malosh and Karen Blatt were certified to the City Charter Commission along with those candidates whose names appeared on the ballot.

The canvass for Beaverton City was then completed and signed.

Canvasser Mary Offenbecker was sworn in for her new term (11/1/01 - 10/30/05).
