WHEREAS, Four Lakes Task Force (FLTF) is submitting to the Department of Natural Resources' (DNR) an application titled "Improved Public Access to the Tittabawassee and Tobacco Rivers near Edenville Michigan" to the Spark Grant Program for improving foot access to the Tittabawassee and Tobacco rivers downstream of the Edenville Dam. Access to the Tobacco River from M-30 is now poorly developed with a steep, unimproved path from a parking lot owned by Gladwin County to the river's edge. WHEREAS, with this resolution of support it is acknowledged that Gladwin County is not committing to any obligations; financial or otherwise.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Gladwin County Board of Commissioners hereby supports submission of the Spark Grant Application to the DNR.
