Board of Canvassers Meeting

Wednesday, November 09, 2022

The Gladwin County Board of Canvassers meeting was called to order at 1:00 p.m., the Pledge of Allegiance was said, role was taken.

Clerk Hulme mentioned to the board that she had placed a phone call to one of the local clerks in anticipation of the Board having questions about that jurisdictions canvass.

Clerk Hulme informed the Board that she would be temporarily unavailable, and that Chief Deputy Clerk, Julie Jackson, would take minutes in her stead.

A motion was made to approve the agenda by Linda Clark, seconded by Linda Hart; all in favor, motion passed.

Meeting called to order at 9:10 a.m.

Discussion was had among the Board of Canvassers and Clerk Hulme regarding the AV Ballot duplication process and the possibility of numbers being over or under as the result of a paper jam in a tabulator. Clerk Hulme noted that the Secord Township Clerk would be in later that morning for any questions regarding the canvass of her jurisdiction.

Canvass of Beaverton City

Canvassing of Gladwin City, Precinct 1

- No remarks were printed and in the Canvassers envelope.

Canvassing of Gladwin City, Precinct 2

- The Board had questions on the AV Ballot numbers and asked the Clerk to call in City Clerk Andrist. Canvass of the City, Precinct 2 was postponed.

Canvassing of Hay Township

Canvassing of Sage Township

- The Clerk administering the Oath to the Chair of the Election Inspectors did not sign this section of the Poll Book.

Canvassing of Sherman Township

- Gladwin City Clerk arrived at the Boards request; this canvass was put on hold.

Return to the Canvassing of Gladwin City, Precinct 2

- City Clerk, Marietta Andrist brought in documentation of AV Ballot numbers. Discussion was had with the Board; all questions were resolved.

Return to the Canvassing of Sherman Township

- Clerks Preparation Certificate was not fully completed

Canvassing of Secord Township

- The Board of Canvassers had questions regarding the number of AV ballots that were not able to be processed. Township Clerk Karen Gawron and Election Inspector Duane Miller were present for discussion. Documentation was provided to the Board on AV

Ballots, and discussion was had on an error with the Electronic Poll Book. The board determined that some AV ballots accounted for "as not processed on election day", were either not ever returned to the Clerk, or surrendered and the voters issued a Regular Ballot. Any ballots that might have been counted by the Board of Canvassers, could not be at this time due to the opening of the AV Ballot Envelope by the Clerk and Deputy Clerk at the precinct earlier this morning. This was done to determine if the AV Ballots in question were in the bag with all the other ballots or in the AV Ballot Envelope. The number of AV Ballots in question were not enough to affect the outcome of the election results.


