The homeowners on the canal on the south side of Pratt Lake are asking for assistance on making the waterway passable.

Due to the actions of the former drain commissioner our lake has been drastically lowered. There has not been enough precipitation over the last three years to bring it to the low "legal level".

This low level has brought on a high level of weed growth and the level is so low that muck is now higher in some places than the water level. <u>This is lowering the property value</u> of the homeowners. It is also damaging to the boaters using this canal.

We are asking for financial assistance to get this canal dredged as it would allow for the homeowners to put their boats in and enjoy the lake for which they are being taxed for.

RE: Tentative Approval of Continuing Lake Improvement Project **BUT** Objection to Special Assessment to 4415 Wagarville Road

Pratt Lake Improvement Board:

My wife Karen and I cannot attend the special assessment public hearing scheduled for September 16, 2023. Please consider this letter a formal written objection pursuant to the letter issued by the Pratt Lake Improvement Board and titled "Notice Of Public Hearings Of Practicability and Assessment".

We are the owners of a home on the NE side of Pratt Lake at 4415 Wagarville Road. We believe the lake improvement project should continue <u>if</u> it helps to degrade the invasive aquatic plants and does <u>not</u> harm humans and the local wildlife including but not limited to animals, birds, fish, amphibians and turtles. If the subject chemicals are toxic, the chemicals should <u>not</u> be used and available alternative safe products should instead be used. The excessive weeds in the lake are not acceptable and will cause further damage to the lake waters and the fishing and the general enjoyment.

Additionally, regardless of whether it is decided to continue with the "lake improvement project", we object to an assessment to our home at 4415 Wagarville Road. This is said because our home and the homes at the NE side of the lake have been refused the benefits of prior lake aquatic plant control. I was told in early summer of 2023 by Chris Meisser that Ray (the lake aquatic plant control person) will not spray at the NE side of the lake. The reason given was that our homes are located near the Curtis farm and that Curtis states that

because our area is near the water inlet/outlet (i.e., the drain by the wetland) he as a farmer does not want "poison" water flowing into his fields and/or poisoning his cattle. Bottom line is that Chris Meisser told me that there was nothing that could be done to include our area of the lake in the aquatic lake control and, if we wanted to reduce/eliminate the overgrown plant life in our area, we had to personally pay to have our areas dredged (via an EGLE permit). As a result of our exclusion from the aquatic plant control applications, our lake front is overgrown and continues to get worse. It is not legally fair to direct a dollar assessment to a homeowner and at the same time intentionally deprive that homeowner of the purpose and the benefit of the assessment.

In summary, (1) we object to the use of chemicals added to the lake for aquatic plant control that are poisonous to living entities, but if the chemicals are not toxic/poisonous we consent to the assessment, but (2) regardless of whether the aquatic lake control special assessment is passed, we request an exemption from the special assessment for the reason that the assessment intentionally excludes us from the benefits and effects of the aquatic plant control.
