



**CANVASS OF VOTES CAST AT THE  
2023 November General Election**

Held on Tuesday, November 07, 2023, Gladwin County, Michigan, and canvassed by the Board of County Canvassers of Gladwin County, Michigan.

**STATEMENT OF VOTES**

The statements of votes polled on Tuesday, November 07, 2023, and filed with the County Clerk, and this Board, having duly examined and considered the statements, do hereby show the whole number of votes given for and against candidates and propositions, reading as follows:

**BEAVERTON CITY, GLADWIN COUNTY, MICHIGAN  
PUBLIC SAFETY PROTECTION RENEWAL PROPOSAL**

Shall the City of Beaverton, Gladwin County, levy a total of two mills (\$2.00 per \$1,000.00) on taxable value of property located in the City of Beaverton for a period of five (5) years beginning with the 2024 tax year and running through 2028 tax levy year (inclusive), which will raise in the first year of such levy as estimated revenue of \$47,362.65 to be used for the purposes of providing public safety services as authorized by law. This levy would be collected on the winter tax bill of 2024 and collected on the winter tax bill thereafter. A portion of these revenues will be captured by the DDA and if approved, this would be a renewal of a previously authorized millage.

**CITY OF BEAVERTON, GLADWIN COUNTY  
AN ADDITIONAL MOSQUITO ABATEMENT PROPOSAL**

Shall the City of Beaverton, Gladwin County, levy an additional annual \$3.25 per parcel of property located in the City of Beaverton to be levied upon each parcel within the corporate limits of the City of Beaverton commencing with the 2024 roll and continue for two (2) years, a period beginning with the 2024 tax year and running through 2025, inclusive, tax levy year , which will raise in the first year of such levy an estimated revenue of \$3,000.00 to be used for the purposes of Mosquito Abatement Special Assessment as authorized by law. This levy would be collected on the winter tax bill of 2024 and collected on the winter tax bill thereafter. A portion of these revenues will be captured by the DOA and if approved, this would be a renewal of a previously authorized millage.

**BILLINGS TOWNSHIP PROPOSAL NO.1  
MOSQUITO CONTROL MILLAGE**

This millage proposal would allow the Township of Billing to Levy 0.6500 of a mill for the purpose of reducing and controlling the mosquito population within the Township.

Shall the Township of Billings, Gladwin County, Michigan, increase the limitation on the total amount of general ad valorem taxes which may be imposed for all purposes in Article 9, Section 6, of the Michigan Constitution of 1963, as amended, by 0.6500 mill. (\$0.65 cents per \$1,000.00 of taxable value) for a period of four (4) years (2023 through 2026, inclusive), which would provide estimated revenues of \$74,853.00 in its first year if approved and levied, for the purpose of reducing and controlling the mosquito population within the township.

### **LAW ENFORCEMENT - PUBLIC SAFETY MILLAGE REQUEST**

To fund Gladwin County Law Enforcement services in Gladwin County, shall the constitutional limitation on the total taxes which may be assessed each year upon all property within the County of Gladwin, Michigan be increased by up to 1 1/2 mills (\$1.50 per \$1,000.00 of state taxable valuation), for a period of six (6) years, from 2023 through 2028, inclusive, commencing with the December 2023 tax collection. If approved and levied in full, this millage will raise an estimated additional \$1,794,253.51 in the first calendar year of the levy, based on state taxable valuation. If approved and levied, a portion of the millage monies raised in respective jurisdictions may be captured by any Tax Increment Financing Authorities, pursuant to State law.

**BEAVERTON SCHOOLS  
OPERATING MILLAGE RENEWAL PROPOSAL**

Shall the currently authorized millage rate limitation of 18.2 mills (\$18.20 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) on the amount of taxes which may be assessed against all property, except principal residence and other property exempted by law, in Beaverton Schools, Gladwin and Clare Counties, Michigan, be renewed for a period of 6 years, 2025 to 2030, inclusive, to provide funds for operating purposes; the estimate of the revenue the school district will collect if the millage is approved and 18 mills are levied in 2025 is approximately \$3,236,857 (this is a renewal of millage that will expire with the 2024 tax levy)?


