WHEREAS, the Michigan Strategic Fund has invited Units of General Local Government to apply for its Community Development Block Grant Disaster Recovery (CDBG-DR) Funding Round; and

WHEREAS, Gladwin County is requesting \$88,400 in CDBG-DR funds to update its Master Plan and Zoning Ordinance in aligning with the County’s hazard mitigation and land use planning strategies in helping to reduce or eliminate the long-term risk of loss in future disasters; and

WHEREAS, the proposed project is consistent with the local Community Development Plan as described in the Application; and

WHEREAS, local funds and any other funds to be invested in the project have not been obligated/incurred and will not be obligated/incurred prior to a formal grant award, completion of the environmental review procedures and a formal written authorization to obligate/incur costs from the Michigan Economic Development Corporation.

The Board of Commissioners authorizes the Gladwin County Board of Commissioner’s Chair, Karen Moore, to submit the Michigan CDBG Application and to sign the Application and all attachments. Furthermore, Gladwin County’s Administrative Assistant/Executive Secretary, Melanie Thume, is authorized to sign Payment Requests.
